Dear Ms. Edwards,

I have lost complete trust in my home state of New Jersey.

The State of New Jersey Judiciary Court System and the New Jersey Capitol Post Office (both referred to as NJ) have demonstrated repeatedly since 2009 that they are incapable of delivering a fair and just legal process. Since the Judiciary appears to be working *for* my defendants, I had no choice but name NJ as a defendant in my Federal case.

Having lived most of my life in New Jersey and being an active contributor to local communities, I had high expectation that my state would provide fair and ample means to resolve disputes and protect me from illegal acts. NJ has proven me wrong.

NJ SUPREME COURT TWICE REJECTS MY APPEAL

Last year my appeal was delivered via U.S. Certified Mail. NJ denied receiving it until the U.S. Postal Service sent proof that it had been received. My package has never been returned.

Earlier this year my appeal was delivered by a Process Server. The fee was returned in just days. The message was quite clear. The NJ Supreme Court had no intention of considering my appeal. I do not know the reason for the change of heart but NJ has proven that it cannot be trusted in my legal matter.

INAPPROPRIATE & QUESTIONABLE ACTIONS

When asked why I should serve Mr. Seiden rather than an attorney from the law firm in the Foreclosure case files, you suggested that a Judge probably made the decision with Mr. Seiden *without recording it*. While that sounds quite plausible it is totally inappropriate. Ex parte communications is never appropriate. As an Arbitrator, my colleagues and I take extra care to avoid even the appearance of ex parte communications. The NJ Supreme Court not only appears to condone this, but the Court validates its acceptance of ex parte communications through case files and communications (i.e. attached letter and our phone conversation).

MY TRUST HAS BEEN DECIMATED

Actions allowed by the State of NJ give the appearance that NJ is working for the defendants rather than providing a fair and balanced legal system for its citizens.

I appreciate your response to my phone call; however, my experience with NJ has been rampant with unfair actions and deceit. Just a few examples are highlighted in recent filings with the U.S. District Court of New Jersey (see Attachment II). Again, I have been waiting almost a year for my appeal package (documents and a USPS money order) to be returned. I have not received anything.

So while you have been quite courteous and responsive, NJ has long proven complicit in my legal effort. The ex parte communications and failure to return my money and documents was the last straw. You may devote best efforts to show fairness now, but the damage has been done due to years of being rebuffed and treated unfairly.

The State of New Jersey is now a defendant in U.S. District Court of New Jersey Case No. 2:16-cv-05301-ES-JAD.

My letters dated March 15, 2017 and April 17, 2017 have advised that in order for this office to proceed with processing your motion for leave to appeal, you must cure the following deficiencies:

- Your motion for leave to appeal was received by this office out of time and cannot be filed. Pursuant to R. 2:5-6(a), a motion for leave to appeal is due within 20 days from the date of service of Appellate Division order. You must submit an original and eight (8) copies of a motion for leave to file the motion for leave to appeal as within time. The motion must include the following: (1) a notice of motion; (2) a certification in support of the motion which demonstrates good cause for the requested relief; and (3) a proof of service reflecting service of your motion upon the Stuart Seiden, Esq.
- The certification of service submitted does not reflect service upon the attorney of record. According to judicial records, Stuart Seiden, Esq. of Duane Morris appeared in the Appellate Division on this matter. You must serve the motion for leave to appeal on Stuart Seiden, Esq., Duane Morris, 30 South 17th St., Philadelphia, PA 19102-4196 and provide a certification of service to the Clerk's Office.
