**NEW JERSEY CONTINUES TO DENY DUE PROCESS
Penalizing Plaintiff (Homeowner) For Court Errors and Lack of Communication**

The State of New Jersey continues to deny the Plaintiff (Homeowner) due process.

The Plaintiff did not have access to the foreclosure case file until last week. Problems with documents filed and failure to notify the Plaintiff continue to mount. The certified mail receipt presented to the Court does not have the Plaintiff's signature. The Plaintiff was never notified of the foreclosure action or of the foreclosure judgment. She only learned about the foreclosure long after the 90-day deadline to respond. The reason for denying the Plaintiff's appeal (see Attachment I) was only possible because The New Jersey Courts failed to notify her of the foreclosure action. Just as the State of New Jersey failed to deliver and return the appeal sent by U.S. Certified Mail, New Jersey Courts failed in the communications to the homeowner in this action. The bottom line is that the State of New Jersey facilitated this foreclosure by denying the homeowner due process.


The Plaintiff's (Homeowner's) foreclosure appeal was re-submitted and rejected because it was filed late. This is the fault of the State of New Jersey. Neither her original appeal nor her payments have been returned.

- She was never notified of the foreclosure hearing on October 2014
- She was not notified that the foreclosure was granted.
- She never was given the opportunity to refute the foreclosure by presenting incorrect financials and other information that confirms the defendants' errors and other duplicitous actions.

Accordingly, employees of the State of New Jersey acknowledge that the Plaintiff's appeal of Case against the defendants (Case Docket No. ESSX L – 004753-13) that was sent within the required timeframe, was not delivered to the NJ Supreme Court.

The State of New Jersey (Courts and Capital Post Office) have systematically and systemically denied the Plaintiff due process. By granting the Plaintiff a jury trial, the District Court will honor her constitutional rights and also help prevent others from suffering the same fate. The facts, processes and other information presented during trial will help legislative long-term efforts to reduce foreclosures and help remove New Jersey from its ranking as the number 1 state in the United States in foreclosures.



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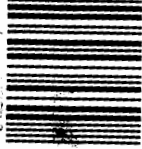
